In what book and chapter questions

B In what book and chapter is the following: "I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you by the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel"
Galatians chapter 1 (G1:6)

B In what book and chapter is the following: "Am I now trying to win the approval of men, or of God? Or am I trying to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a servant of Christ."
Galatians chapter 1 (G1:10)

B In what book and chapter is the following: "They only heard the report: 'The man who formerly persecuted us is now preaching the faith he once tried to destroy.'"
Galatians chapter 1. (G1:23)

B In what book and chapter is the following: This matter arose because some false brothers had infiltrated our ranks to spy on the freedom we have in Christ Jesus and to make us slaves.
Galatians chapter 2 (G2:4)

B In what book and chapter is the following: All they asked was that we should continue to remember the poor, the very thing I was eager to do.
Galatians chapter 2 (G2:10)

B In what book and chapter is the following: "We who are Jews by birth and not 'Gentile sinners' know that a man is not justified by observing the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ. So we, too, have put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by observing the law, because by observing the law no one will be justified.
Galatians chapter 2 (G2:15-16)

B In what book and chapter is the following: I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Consider Abraham: "He believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness

B In what book and chapter is the following: Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree.

B In what book and chapter is the following: What, then, was the purpose of the law? It was added because of transgressions until the Seed to whom the promise referred had come. The law was put into effect through angels by a mediator.

Galatians chapter 3 (G3:19)

B In what book and chapter is the following: There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

B In what book and chapter is the following: 1It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.

Galatians chapter 5 (G5:1)

B In what book and chapter is the following: 6For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision has any value. The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love.

B In what book and chapter is the following: "A little yeast works through the whole batch of dough."

Galatians chapter 5 (G5:9)

B In what book and chapter is the following: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

B In what book and chapter is the following: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Anyone who receives instruction in the word must share all good things with his instructor.

B In what book and chapter is the following: A man reaps what he sows.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Finally, let no one cause me trouble, for I bear on my body the marks of Jesus.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.

B In what book and chapter is the following: In him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will,
Ephesians chapter 1 (E1:11)

B In what book and chapter is the following: I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.
Ephesians chapter 1 (E1:17)

B In what book and chapter is the following: All of us also lived among them at one time, gratifying the cravings of our sinful nature and following its desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature objects of wrath.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to his neighbor, for we are all members of one body

B In what book and chapter is the following: Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Ephesians chapter 4 (E4:32)

B In what book and chapter is the following: For of this you can be sure: No immoral, impure or greedy person—such a man is an idolater—has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.

Ephesians chapter 5 (E5:5)

B In what book and chapter is the following: and find out what pleases the Lord.

Ephesians chapter 5 (E5:10)

B In what book and chapter is the following: For it is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret.

Ephesians chapter 5 (E5:12)

B In what book and chapter is the following: "Wake up, O sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you."

Ephesians chapter 5 (E5:14)

B In what book and chapter is the following: Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

B In what book and chapter is the following: "For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh."

B In what book and chapter is the following: "Honor your father and mother"—which is the first commandment with a promise

B In what book and chapter is the following: And masters, treat your slaves in the same way. Do not threaten them, since you know that he who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and there is no favoritism with him.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Pray also for me, that whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel,

Ephesians chapter 6 (E6:19)

B In what book and chapter is the following: God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus.

Philippians chapter 1 (P1:8)

B In what book and chapter is the following: It is true that some preach Christ out of envy and rivalry, but others out of goodwill.

B In what book and chapter is the following: For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.

B In what book and chapter is the following: I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death,
Philippians chapter 3 (P3:10)

B In what book and chapter is the following: But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ,
Philippians chapter 3 (P3:20)

B In what book and chapter is the following: Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!
Philippians chapter 4 (P4:4)

B In what book and chapter is the following: Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
Philippians chapter 4 (P4:6)

B In what book and chapter is the following: I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want.

Philippians chapter 4 (P4:12)

B In what book and chapter is the following: And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.

B In what book and chapter is the following: You learned it from Epaphras, our dear fellow servant, who is a faithful minister of Christ on our behalf,

B In what book and chapter is the following: For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves

Colossians chapter 1 (C1:13)

B In what book and chapter is the following: He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

Colossians chapter 1 (C1:17)

B In what book and chapter is the following: Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior.

Colossians chapter 1 (C1:21)

B In what book and chapter is the following: We proclaim him, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone perfect in Christ.

B In what book and chapter is the following: My purpose is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ,

B In what book and chapter is the following: In him you were also circumcised, in the putting off of the sinful nature, not with a circumcision done by the hands of men but with the circumcision done by Christ,

B In what book and chapter is the following: Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

B In what book and chapter is the following: And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Colossians chapter 3 (C3:17)

B In what book and chapter is the following: Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men,

Colossians chapter 3 (C3:23)

B In what book and chapter is the following: Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.

B In what book and chapter is the following: Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.
